TIDAL BASIN WELCOME AREA AND ANA STAGE OFFERS FREE PERFORMANCES AMONG THE BLOSSOMS

Washington, **DC** [March 6, 2019] – The National Cherry Blossom Festival will offer free performances, educational programs, and hands-on activities at the <u>Tidal Basin Welcome Area and ANA Stage</u> each weekend of the Festival (March 23-24, March 30-31, April 6-7, April 13-14) as well as weekdays while the trees are in bloom.

Activities at the Welcome Area will be presented by the National Park Service (NPS).
