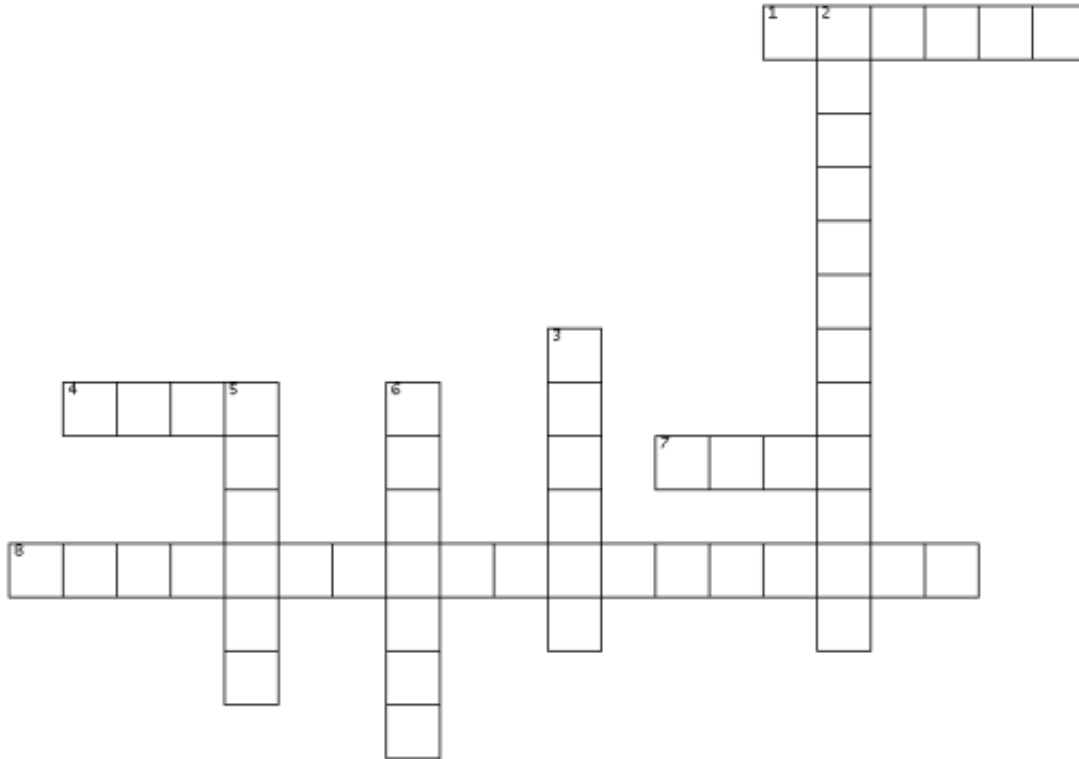




Cherry Blossoms of Smithsonian Gardens
